An effective permit is required for water quality improvement and protection

Effectively prohibit non-storm water discharges into storm sewers


Require controls to reduce the discharge of pollutants in storm water to the maximum extent practicable

Restore and maintain the physical, chemical, and biological integrity of receiving waters
