SUBJECT: **Hanson Aggregates, San Francisco Sand Yard, San Francisco County** – Hearing to Consider Mandatory Minimum Penalty for Discharge of Partially Treated Wastewater to Waters of the State

CHRONOLGY: MMP - April 2002.

DISCUSSION: Hanson Aggregates, San Francisco Sand Yard, had a total of 28 effluent limit violations of its NPDES permit 98-062 during the period between August 1, 2002, and March 31, 2003. Twenty-seven of these violations are subject to a mandatory minimum penalty of \$81,000.

The complaint (Attachment A) imposed an MMP in the total amount of \$81,000. Hanson Aggregates, San Francisco Sand Yard, has signed a waiver to a Water Board hearing, and intends to undertake a supplemental environmental project (SEP).
