CHRONOLOGY:	1996 – Adoption of Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for Pescadero Solid Waste Disposal Site
DISCUSSION:	The Revised Tentative Order (Appendix A) updates WDRs for the Pescadero Solid Waste Disposal Site (Landfill).
	The Landfill, located between the town of Pescadero and the Pacific coastline, consists of an older seven acre portion, and a newer 54 acre portion. Non-hazardous waste was disposed at the Landfill between 1962 and 1986. Both the older and newer portions of the Landfill are covered with clean soil. Current site monitoring indicates no significant water quality impacts to surfacewater and groundwater at or near the Landfill.
	The Tentative Order includes requirements necessary to properly close and monitor the newer portion of the Landfill, and to confirm that water quality in the area of the older portion of the Landfill has not been significantly impacted.
	We circulated the Tentative Order to the San Mateo County Department of Public Works and interested parties. We have revised the Tentative Order as appropriate, based on comments provided by the Department (attached), and consider all issues resolved.
