SUBJECT: General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharge or Reuse of

Extracted and Treated Groundwater Resulting from the Cleanup of Groundwater Polluted by Fuel Leaks and Other Related Wastes at Service Stations and Similar Sites - Reissuance of NPDES General

Permit

**CHRONOLOGY**: September 2001 - Permit reissued

**DISCUSSION:** This general permit regulates the discharge of extracted groundwater from

fuel leak and similar cleanup sites. There are currently 55 active

discharges covered under this general permit. Within the next five years, we expect approximately 20 more groundwater cleanup sites will require

coverage under this general permit. The Revised Tentative Order

(Appendix A) is substantially the same as the expired general permit with

the following exception: effluent limitations for MTBE (a gasoline additive) and vinyl chloride were lowered to be consistent with USEPA

guidance.

We received minor comments on the Tentative Order from USEPA (Appendix B), and revised the Tentative Order accordingly. The attached Revised Tentative Order reflects these changes along with additional changes for clarity. We expect the Revised Tentative Order to remain

uncontested.
