ITEM: 6 City of Burlingame, Wastewater Treatment Plant, San Mateo County SUBJECT: - Hearing to Consider Mandatory Minimum Penalty for Discharge in Violation of Effluent Limitations CHRONOLOGY: Mandatory Minimum Penalty (MMP) Complaints were issued February 2001, July 2003, and September 2004. DISCUSSION: The City violated its cyanide effluent limit two times between July 1, 2004, and April 30, 2007. Both of these violations are subject to an MMP. In August, we issued a complaint to the City assessing \$6,000 in mandatory minimum penalties. The violations covered by this complaint are minor in nature, so the minimum penalty is sufficient. The City has changed its analytical procedures, which appears to have addressed the cause of the violations. The City waived its right to a hearing (see Appendix B) and has proposed a Supplemental Environmental Project. The Project would expand an existing sewage education program in Burlingame's public upper and middle schools. **RECOMMEND-**ATION: No action is necessary. File Number: 2179.7005(CEB) A.
