CHRONOLOGY:

May 2007 - Site Cleanup Requirements adopted

DISCUSSION:

The Tentative Resolution (Appendix A) is for adoption of a Negative Declaration (Appendix B) pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), for which the Board is the lead agency. This Tentative Resolution is complimentary to this month's Item 5E, the Site Cleanup Requirements Order (Revised Tentative Order) for the site.

The Revised Tentative Order requires the dischargers to implement their final cleanup plan and conduct long-term monitoring at the site. A general project description and a summary of the Revised Tentative Order can be found in the Staff Summary Report for Item 5E.

The project, as defined for the purposes of the CEQA evaluation, consists of the adoption of the Revised Tentative Order and associated Self-Monitoring Program, and implementation of the final cleanup plan. The Negative Declaration and supporting Initial Study find no substantial evidence that the project as implemented may have a significant effect on the environment.

Staff did not receive any comments related to the Negative Declaration and Initial Study during the public comment period. We expect this item to remain uncontested.
