DISCUSSION:

Based on information recently received, this item will be continued to a future Board meeting to allow time to evaluate the naming of additional dischargers to the site cleanup requirements' tentative order. We have asked several individuals for additional information and envision a several-month continuance, so that we can review this additional information and, if appropriate, add additional parties to the tentative order, recirculate a revised tentative order for public comment, and

prepare the matter for Board hearing.

A several-month continuance should not have adverse effects on human health or water quality. We have used a Water Code section 13267 directive to require the dischargers currently named in the tentative order to complete two early tasks: completion of a conduit study, and a public

participation plan.
