GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR Discharges of Process Wastewaters from Aggregate Mining, Marine Sand Washing, and Sand Offloading Facilities to Surface Waters

Water Board staff has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System general permit for new and existing discharges of wastewaters from aggregate mining, marine sand washing, and sand offloading operations in the San Francisco Bay Region. It contains requirements in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft permit is 5:00 p.m. on April 1, 2015. Comments must be sent to the attention of Farhad Azimzadeh. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspects of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft permit during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **July 8, 2015**, in the Auditorium at 1515 Clay Street in Oakland. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
