Reissued Waste Discharge Requirements For City of Suisun City Pierce Island Dredged Material Disposal Site

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) will consider at a public hearing adopting a Tentative Order containing Reissued Waste Discharge Requirements for the City of Suisun City's operation of the Pierce Island Dredged Material Disposal Site. The Tentative Order addresses the disposal of hydraulically dredged sediment from Suisun City Marina, the Marina Village Residential District, and associated navigation access channels in or adjacent to the northern terminus of Suisun Slough onto ponds located at the site.

SUBMISSION OF WRITTEN COMMENTS: The 30-day public comment period for the Tentative Order will begin on April 15, 2019. Written comments on the Tentative Order must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m. on May 16, 2019, to the staff contact identified above. Additionally, all evidence, testimony, and exhibits to be offered at the hearing must be submitted in writing by this date and time to the above staff contact. Non-evidentiary policy statements to be made at the hearing need not be submitted in advance.

A week prior to the hearing, Water Board staff will post on its website any proposed changes to the Tentative Order, along with written responses to comments received during the public comment period.

PROCEDURAL MATTERS: The public hearing will be conducted in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, title 23, section 648 et seq. The Water Board will receive oral public testimony on the Tentative Order at the hearing. Time limits may be imposed on oral testimony at the public hearing.
