NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON AMENDMENT OF SITE CLEANUP REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MARTINEZ REFINERY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) will accept written comments on the Tentative Order for Amendment of Site Cleanup Requirements (SCRs) for Martinez Refining Company, LLC, Shell Oil Products US and Equilon Enterprises, LLC (the Dischargers).

The Order would amend the existing SCR Order for the ongoing remediation of chemicals in groundwater at the former Shell Martinez Refinery. This Order recognizes the transfer of ownership of the Refinery from Shell Oil Products US and Equilon Enterprises, LLC to Martinez Refining Company, LLC, a subsidiary of PBF Holding Company, LLC, and adds Martinez Refining Company, LLC to the list of parties responsible for complying with the existing SCRs, Order Number R2-2014-0025.
