NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) will accept written comments on the Tentative Order for Amendments of Waste Discharge Requirements (WDRs) for Disposal and Onsite Use of Non-Designated and Non-Hazardous Contaminated Soils and Related Wastes at Active Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) Landfills. The Order would clarify and standardize the acceptance criteria for contaminated soils at the Region's nine active MSW landfills.
