NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) will accept written comments on the Tentative Order for Rescission of Site Cleanup Requirements (SCRs) for the former Napa Pipe Facility.

The Order would rescind the existing SCRs (Order No. R2-1990-0147) for the cleanup of chemicals in soil and groundwater at the former Napa Pipe Facility, which is located south of the City of Napa. The SCR Order is no longer needed because the cleanup has been completed.
