### **NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON RESCISSION OF SITE CLEANUP REQUIREMENTS FOR THE TRANSMONTAIGNE MARTINEZ TERMINAL**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) will accept written comments on the Tentative Order for Rescission of Site Cleanup Requirements (SCRs) for the TransMontaigne (formerly Pacific Atlantic) Martinez Terminal.

The Order would rescind the existing SCR Order for the ongoing remediation of chemicals in soil and groundwater at this active petroleum storage terminal because the cleanup goals established in Order No. R2-2008-0076 have been achieved.
