## NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING FOR DISCHARGE PERMIT

Union Sanitary District Raymond A. Boege Alvarado Wastewater Treatment Plant Old Alameda Creek Intermittent Wet Weather Discharge 5072 Benson Road, Union City, CA 94587, Alameda County

Board staff has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for the above discharger in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

Union Sanitary District owns and operates a wastewater treatment plant that provides secondary treatment. Most of these discharges occur in Lower San Francisco Bay and are covered under a separate permit. This draft permit would cover intermittent discharges of treated wastewater to Old Alameda Creek during extreme wet weather, which will occur up to about 12 times per year.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft permit is 5:00 p.m. on September 3, 2020. Comments must be sent to the attention of James Parrish. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft permit during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **October 14, 2020**. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
