**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT AND PUBLIC HEARING  
FOR  
DISCHARGE PERMIT**

**Sanitary District No. 5 of Marin County  
Paradise Cove Treatment Plant  
3700 Paradise Drive, Marin County**

Board staff has prepared a draft National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System permit for the above discharger in accordance with the Clean Water Act and Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act.

Sanitary District No. 5 of Marin County collects and treats domestic wastewater from an unincorporated area within the Town of Tiburon and discharges up to 0.04 million gallons per day of treated wastewater from the Paradise Cove Treatment Plant to Central San Francisco Bay. The draft permit would cover this discharge.

The deadline for receipt of comment on the draft permit is **5:00 p.m. on August 9, 2021**. Comments must be sent to the **attention of James Parrish**. Persons wishing to file written comments on any aspect of this matter must do so no later than this deadline so that such comments may be considered.

The Board will consider adopting the draft permit during a meeting to commence at 9:00 a.m. on **September 8, 2021**. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
