**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board has prepared a Tentative Order rescinding Site Cleanup Requirements Order No. R2-2004-0086 because the requirements have been satisfied Specifically, the City of Oakland and Port of Oakland have completed the cleanup requirements for petroleum-impacted soil and groundwater, primarily associated with former underground storage and aboveground storage tank locations, at the above-referenced property.
