NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board) will accept written comments on the Tentative Cease and Desist Order to the City of Vallejo and Vallejo Flood and Waste Water District in Solano County.

This Tentative Cease and Desist Order is for violation of the Municipal Regional Stormwater Permit Trash Reduction Requirements.

PUBLIC HEARING

The Board will consider adopting the Tentative Cease and Desist Order during a meeting to commence at **9:00 am** on **December 10, 2025**, in the Auditorium on the first floor at 1515 Clay Street, Oakland, CA 94612. Interested persons are invited to express their views at this hearing. After the Board considers adoption of the Tentative Cease and Desist Order, Water Board staff will present an information item on the 100 percent trash load reduction requirement under Provision C.10.a.i of the Municipal Regional Stormwater NPDES Permit.

Pursuant to California Code of Regulations Title 23 section 2050(c), any party who challenges the Board's action through a petition to the State Water Resources Control Board under Water Code section 13320 will be limited to raising only those substantive issues that were raised before the Board at the hearing or in timely submitted correspondence.
