## NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND STIPULATED ORDER in the matter of

## CITY OF ST. HELENA EFFLUENT LIMIT VIOLATIONS

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Water Board) Prosecution Team and the City of St. Helena have entered into a proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order. The proposal would impose an administrative civil liability against the City of St. Helena in the amount of \$378,000 for alleged discharge limit violations.

The proposal would allow \$196,500 to be suspended pending completion of a supplemental environmental project to replace aging sewer pipelines near Sulphur Creek in Napa County at risk of inflow and infiltration and leaking sewage.
