## NOTICE OF PROPOSED SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND STIPULATED ORDER

## in the matter of Stuart Depper, Former Glovatorium Facility Alameda County

The California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Water Board) Prosecution Team and Mr. Stuart Depper have entered into a proposed Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Order that would impose \$17,500 in administrative civil liability against Mr. Depper.

This proposed liability is based on allegations that Mr. Depper failing to submit complete technical reports required by Water Code section 13267. The technical reports were needed for environmental investigations of perchloroethylene (PCE), Stoddard solvent, and oil at the former Glovatorium facility.
