# REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD - SAN FRANCISCO BAY BOARD MEETING MINUTES

# January 12, 2011

### Item 1 - Roll Call and Introductions

The meeting was called to order on January 12, 2011 at 9:03 a.m. in the Elihu M. Harris Building, First Floor Auditorium, 1515 Clay Street, Oakland.

Board members present: John Muller, Chair; Terry Young, Vice-Chair; Shalom Eliahu; James McGrath; Steven Moore; William Peacock; Rameshwar Singh.

Board members absent: None.

At the request of Mr. Muller, Board members, members of the audience, and staff observed a moment of silence in honor of those who lost their lives in a recent tragedy.

Tam M. Doduc, Member, State Water Resources Control Board, and liaison to Region 2, addressed the Board.

## Item 2 – Election of Chair and Vice-Chair

Dr. Young served as Chair during the election of Year 2011 Board Chair. She requested nominations. Mr. Eliahu said he appreciated Mr. Muller's work and nominated Mr. Muller. The nomination was seconded by Mr. Moore. Dr. Singh made a motion to close nominations. There were no further nominations. Dr. Young requested a roll call vote.

Mr. Muller began serving as Year 2011 Chair. He thanked staff for its work and dedication and for doing more with less. He said it is a privilege to work with the Board members and thanked the Board for giving him the opportunity to serve as Chair.

Mr. Muller requested nominations for Year 2011 Vice-Chair. Mr. Eliahu nominated Dr. Young and the nomination was seconded by Mr. Peacock. There were no further nominations. Mr. Muller requested a motion to close nominations. Mr. Peacock made the motion and Mr. McGrath seconded the motion. Mr. Muller requested a roll call vote.

Dr. Young expressed appreciation for the level of professionalism and scientific expertise that staff puts into its work. She expressed appreciation for the involvement in Regional Board issues by permittees and the community at large in the environmental community. She said she learns a great deal from their comments. Doduc, Member, State Water Resources Control Board, and liaison to Region 2, for helping the Regional Board deal with issues in the Bay Area.

### Item 3 - Public Forum

Stephen Knight, Political Director, Save The Bay, thanked the Board for its leadership in reducing trash in San Francisco Bay. He spoke favorably about a single-use carryout bag ordinance adopted by a local municipality. He said Save The Bay is working with Bay Area cities and counties to pass source reduction bills.

Item 5 – Chairman's, Board Members' and Executive Officer's Reports

Mr. Moore said he would like to reiterate the Board's appreciation for efforts staff takes in preparing the written Executive Officer's Report each month.

Mr. Wolfe said he was willing to go to city council meetings to speak in favor of bans on single-use carryout bags. He said bans allow the public to be actively involved in controlling trash.

# Item 6 – Consideration of Uncontested Items

Mr. Wolfe recommended continuance of Item 6A. He said Item 6B was a status report and no Board action was required.

Item 7 – <u>City of Petaluma, Ellis Creek Water Recycling Facility and Its Collection</u>
<u>System, Petaluma, Marin County</u> – Reissuance of NPDES Permit

Mr. Wolfe made introductory comments. Vince Christian gave the staff presentation. Pamela Tuft, Interim Director, Department of Water Resources and Conservation, City of Petaluma, thanked Mr. Christian, Bill Johnson, and Lila Tang for their work on the Revised Tentative Order and spoke in favor of its adoption by the Board.

Mr. Moore, Dr. Young, Mr. McGrath, and Mr. Muller complimented the City on the Ellis Creek Water Recycling Facility. Ms. Tuft and Monica Oakley, Consultant, speaking on behalf of the City of Petaluma, replied to Board members' questions.

Mr. Wolfe said specific sections that were referred to within the Revised Tentative Order should be corrected. He said staff would make the necessary corrections. He recommended adoption of the Revised Tentative Order with the corrections.

recommended by the Executive Officer.
