The San Francisco Bay Water Board is hosting an Annual Monitoring Workshop for enrollees in the Grazing Regulatory Program on Tuesday, October 6th, from 1:30 to 4:00 p.m. at the Sonoma Mountain Institute Home Ranch, located at 4080 Manor Lane, Petaluma, CA. Attendees will learn how to conduct annual monitoring and complete the [Annual Certification Form](#) required for compliance with the water quality permit for grazing operations. The workshop will be held outdoors, rain or shine. During the workshop, we will walk an easy one-mile loop on an all-season road. Attendees who may have difficulty walking are welcome to follow the group in their vehicles.

Stay to the right and continue following Manor Lane until it dead ends at two gates. Enter through the open gate on the right. At the fork in the road, take the road on the right and please drive slowly. After 3 or 4 minutes, you'll pass through another open gate and see a large barn and parking area on the right. Park anywhere near the barn. The workshop will begin in the barn.
