## Announcing a Public Workshop

to discuss upcoming

## **Grazing Requirements in Tomales Bay Watersheds**

Staff of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, San Francisco Bay Region (Water Board) will hold a public workshop to discuss upcoming regulations for grazing lands on August 23, 2007 in Pt. Reyes Station. The new regulations will implement the Policy for Implementation and Enforcement of the Nonpoint Source Pollution Control Program (2004, "the Nonpoint Source Policy") and the Tomales Bay Pathogen Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL).

In the coming months the Water Board will propose a Conditional Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements for grazing lands with requirements for:

- 1. Program participation and registration
- 2. Grazing lands inventory and assessment
- 3. Pollution prevention/reduction activities (actions to reduce water pollution caused by pathogens, nutrients, and sediment/erosion from grazing lands)
- 4. Compliance timeframe
- 5. Compliance monitoring
