YOU ARE HEREBY GIVEN NOTICE THAT:

1. Knott's Berry Farm (Knott's) is alleged to have violated provisions of law for which the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region (Board), must impose mandatory penalties pursuant to California Water Code (CWC) Section 13385.
2. A hearing concerning this complaint will be held before the Board within 90 days of the date of issuance of this complaint, unless Knott's waives its right to a hearing. If the hearing in this matter is not waived, the hearing will be held during the Board's regular meeting on August 22, 2003 at the Orange County Water District in Fountain Valley. Knott's or its representatives will have an opportunity to appear and be heard and to contest the allegations in this complaint and the imposition of mandatory penalties by the Board.
3. This complaint is based on the following facts:
  - a.) On October 17, 1997, the Board adopted Order No. 97-57 (NPDES No. CA0106496), prescribing waste discharge requirements for the discharge of storm water runoff and ornamental water discharges from Knott's to storm drains located at La Palma Avenue, Western Avenue and Beach Boulevard. The Board reissued these waste discharge requirements under Order No. R8-2003-0014 on February 21, 2003.
  - b.) Knott's submitted self-monitoring reports indicating that Knott's exceeded discharge limits specified in Order No. 97-57 for total dissolved solids, settleable solids and pH. These violations are summarized in Attachment "A" (page 3) of this complaint.
4. CWC Section 13385 (i) requires the Board to assess a mandatory minimum penalty of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) for each effluent limitation violation, not counting the first three violations if they are considered non-serious.
5. As shown in Attachment "A", Knott's incurred a total of twenty-six violations between March 2000 and June 2002. In accordance with CWC Section 13385 (i), twenty-five of these violations are subject to a mandatory minimum penalty. The minimum penalty for these violations is \$75,000.
6. In accordance with CWC Section 13385(c), the Board may impose administrative civil liability for the violations cited in Attachment "A". The maximum administrative civil liability that may be imposed for these violations is \$260,000.

7. The Regional Board's Executive Officer proposes that a mandatory minimum penalty of \$75,000 be imposed on Knott's by the Board for the violations cited above.
8. Knott's has indicated that they wish to waive their right to a hearing in this matter and participate in a supplemental environmental project. Knott's has chosen to contribute \$45,000 of the penalty to the Kelp Reforestation Project sponsored by the Orange County Coast Keeper. The remaining portion (\$30,000) will be paid to the State Water Resources Control Board.
9. Mandatory Minimum Penalty Complaint No. R8-2003-0060, issued on June 4, 2003, is hereby revoked.

### **MANDATORY MINIMUM PENALTY COMPLAINT NO. R8-2003-0094, KNOTT'S BERRY FARM**

Dear Mr. McDaniel:

Enclosed is Mandatory Minimum Penalty Complaint No. R8-2003-0094. This complaint replaces Mandatory Minimum Penalty Complaint No. R8-2003-0060 that I issued to Knott's Berry Farm on June 4, 2003. Complaint No. R8-2003-0060 was issued pursuant to California Water Code Section 13385 (h) and (i) and proposed the assessment of a penalty of \$75,000 for violations of effluent limitations established in your waste discharge requirements, Order No. 97-57 (NPDES No. CA0106496). Complaint No. R8-2003-0094 still proposes an assessment of a penalty of \$75,000. However, it also reflects your desire to participate in a supplemental environmental project for payment of a portion of the assessment. We understand that you have chosen to contribute \$45,000 of the liability to the Kelp Reforestation Project sponsored by the Orange County Coast Keeper.

By August 15, 2003, please sign the enclosed waiver form and submit it, along with the bottom portion of the attached invoice and payment, to the State Water Resources Control Board at the address on the invoice. In addition, please submit a check in the amount of \$45,000 made payable to the Orange County Coast Keeper, along with a copy of the signed waiver, to our office.
