Complaint

Pursuant to California Water Code (“Water Code”) Sections 13323 and 13399.33 and California Government Code Section 11415.60, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region (“Regional Water Board”) hereby finds:

1. The Assistant Executive Officer of the Regional Water Board issued Administrative Civil Liability Complaint R8-2019-0048 (incorporated into this order as Attachment 1) against B&W Custom Restaurant Equipment, Inc. (Discharger) on May 7, 2019, which proposed a mandatory minimum penalty in the amount of \$7,040, pursuant to Water Code section 13399.33, subdivisions (a)(1) and (d).
2. On June 3, 2019, the Discharger submitted a signed Waiver (incorporated into this Order as Attachment 2), electing to waive its right to a hearing before the Regional Water Boards and agreeing to pay the proposed penalty amount of \$7,040.
3. The signed Waiver and agreement to pay the proposed penalty constitutes a proposed settlement of the Complaint.
4. The proposed settlement was posted for a 30-day public notice and comment period on June 17, 2019. The public comment period closed on July 16, 2019. The Regional Water Board did not receive any comments on the proposed settlement.
5. The action to adopt this Order approving the settlement proposal, which resolves the Administrative Civil Liability Complaint, is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act, in accordance with Title 14, California Code of Regulations (Enforcement actions by Regulatory Agencies), Section 15321 (a)(2).
6. Any aggrieved person may petition the State Water Board to review this action by the Regional Water Board in accordance with Water Code section 13320 and the State Water Board’s regulations. The petition must be received by the State Water Board within 30 days of the date of this Order. Copies of the law and regulations applicable
