#### Item \*9. Waste Discharge Requirements for Minor Ranch, LLC, Menifee Valley Specific Plan Project, Menifee, Riverside County

The Santa Ana Water Board will consider the adoption of waste discharge requirements authorizing the discharge of fill material to waters of the state for the Menifee Valley Specific Plan Project in Menifee, Riverside County (Project). The Project includes the construction of a master planned community consisting of a mix of uses including residential, commercial, business park, public facilities, and open space, with additional on-site and off-site infrastructure improvements.

#### Item 11. Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Case Study - ARCO #5346

Santa Ana Water Board staff will present a case study on a recently closed underground storage tank clean up case in the Santa Ana Region. The presentation will be centered on the timeline of the case from discovery of release, through the investigation phase, remediation design and implementation, and determination of closure eligibility under the statewide Low Threat Closure Policy. ARCO #5346 is located at 250 Diamond Drive in Lake Elsinore. In December 1998, gasoline impacted soil was discovered in samples collected during fuel dispenser upgrade work. Site assessment work included installation, monitoring, and sampling of over 30 groundwater monitoring wells to delineate the groundwater plume. Remedial efforts included groundwater extraction and treatment, which treated over 4 million gallons of impacted groundwater. In December 2022, the Santa Ana Water Board determined Site conditions met the State Water Resources Control Board's Low Threat Underground Storage Tank Case Closure Policy and issued the 60-day public notification of case closure, followed by a No Further Action determination in June 2023.
