Item *7. Waste Discharge Requirements for Gateway at Grand Terrace Specific Plan Project; City of Grand Terrace, San Bernardino County

The Santa Ana Water Board will consider the adoption of Waste Discharge Requirements for Order R8-2025-0055 for the Gateway at Grand Terrace Specific Plan Project within the City of Grand Terrace in San Bernardino County. The Project encompasses the construction of 695 residential dwelling units and 335,700 square feet of non-residential uses on a total of 111.9. The Project proposes a mix of residential, commercial, and public facilities land uses. The construction of the Project would result in the permanent physical loss of 0.53 acre of stream channel and wetland acre waters of the State.

The construction of the Project would result in the permanent physical loss of 0.05-acre of ephemeral waters of the State.

Item *9. Waste Discharge Requirements for Oak Hills West Residential Tract 38652; City of Menifee, Riverside County

The Santa Ana Water Board will consider the adoption of Waste Discharge Requirements for Order R8-2025-0063 for the Oak Hills W Residential T38652 Project within the City of Menifee in Riverside County. The Project encompasses the development of a single-family residential subdivision, to provide additional residential housing units and associated infrastructure. The Project consists of 37 residential lots plus a common area on an approximately 15.5-acre, of a 77.81-acre property. The remainder of the property will remain undisturbed open space. The Project will result in the permanent physical loss of 0.39 acres of ephemeral streambed.
