The Project's purpose is to construct a new bikeway and pedestrian trail within and adjacent to Orange Street in the Cities of Highland and Redlands. The Project will result in temporary impacts of 0.16 acres of streambed associated with construction access.

Item 7. National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit and Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges of Pollutants in Urban Runoff from the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4s) in the Counties of Orange, Riverside, and San Bernardino, Order R8-2026-0034 (NPDES No. CAS618000)

The Santa Ana Water Board will hold a public hearing to receive public comments on Order R8-2026-0034 for regulating discharges of pollutants in urban runoff from MS4s in Orange, Riverside, and San Bernardino Counties on a regionwide basis (Tentative Order). The Tentative Order combines and supersedes Orders R8-2009-0030, R8-2010-0033, and R8-2010-0036. Parties and interested persons will have the opportunity to address the Santa Ana Water Board on the Tentative Order. The Santa Ana Water Board will take no action at this meeting on the Tentative Order but may give direction to staff. The Santa Ana Water Board will close the hearing on July 24th. The Santa Ana Water Board intends to consider adoption of the Tentative Order at a meeting on 9:00 a.m. on August 21, 2026, at 25541 Barton Road in the city of Loma Linda (Loma Linda City Hall). The agenda for that meeting will be provided at a future date. The deadline to submit written comments on the Tentative Order is July 20, 2026. No new written materials may be submitted on the Tentative Order after 5:00 p.m. on July 20, 2026.
