## Item 3. Regional Board Meeting Minutes of May 15, 2020

Chair Ruh asked the Board Members for a motion of the Minutes and asked Ms. Aguilar to do a roll call vote on July 30, 2020.

#### Item 4. Renewal of Waste Discharge Requirements and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit (NPDES No. CA8000403) for Poseidon Resources (Surfside) L.L.C., Huntington Beach Desalination Facility – Order Number R8-2020-0005

This item was presented by Regional Board staff, Hope Smythe, Jayne Joy, Ann Sturdivant, Julio Lara, Terri Reeder, and State Board staff, Daniel Ellis.

The Board meeting on Friday, August 7, 2020, is to consider the Renewal of Waste Discharge Requirements and NPDES Permit of the California Water Code Section 13142.5(b) and it is the Determination for Poseidon Resources, Huntington Beach Desalination Facility.

Hope Smythe, Executive Officer, provided a presentation to the Board members and said that she would like to review the new comments that we heard at the hearing on July 30, 2020 and July 31, 2020. She stated that there are some proposed changes to the mitigation approach for the proposed project and she would provide an overview.

Board members discussed the mitigation acreage, restoration acreages, the Ocean Plan, dredging the inlet and more acreage in Bolsa Chica, Attachment K in the Tentative Order and many other aspects of this project. Board members engaged in a long and deliberated discussion.

Board members asked for a complete mitigation plan that would include finance. Mr. Bishop said it is the discharger's responsibility to propose a full mitigation plan which the staff would review and bring to the Board for final approval. Mr. Bishop mentioned that there are all sorts of things that need to be done for a complete mitigation plan, and at this point the plan is not there, with the understanding or desire to move forward, staff proposed a conditional plan. Mr. Bishop proposed that the Board give clear direction to staff on the recommended changes to the permit.

Board members unanimously agreed that changes need to be done to the permit, therefore, they were not able to vote on August 7, 2020. Vice Chair William von Blasingame suggested another Board meeting prior to a vote. Board members agreed to September 17, 2020. Regional Board staff would make the necessary revisions as appropriate for the permit and for consideration of approval from the Board.
