NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region (Santa Ana Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment tentative Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. R8-2022-0041 (Tentative Order) for Inland Empire Utilities Agency's (IEUA's) Regional Water Recycling Facilities (RWRFs). Using a mailing address of P.O. Box 9020, Chino Hills, CA 91709, IEUA applied for reissuance of the current NPDES permit, Order R8-2015-0036, under section 402 of the federal Clean Water Act (33 U.S.C. § 1342) for the following locations:

IEUA owns and operates four RWRFs that are in the southwestern area of San Bernardino County and produce tertiary treated and disinfected recycled water for non-potable and indirect potable reuse. The Tentative Order authorizes the production and distribution of recycled water and the discharge of tertiary treated and disinfected effluent to tributaries of Reach 3 of the Santa Ana River. It also authorizes the discharge of storm water to Reach 1 of Cucamonga Creek and Reach 1B of Chino Creek.
