TENTATIVE ORDER R8-2023-0001**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board (Santa Ana Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment tentative Order R8-2023-0001 (Tentative Order), which will replace existing Order R8-2004-0008, amended by Orders R8-2008-0094 and R8-2016-0052 to serve as Waste Discharge Requirements for discharges of waste at the California Street Landfill. California Street Landfill is a Class III non-hazardous municipal solid waste disposal facility located at 2151 Nevada Street in Redlands. The Tentative Order contains waste discharge requirements that are consistent with California Code of Regulations, title 27, division 2, subdivision 1 and Code of Federations Regulations, title 40, subpart D of part 258, the Basin Plan, and other pertinent federal and State laws and regulations for municipal solid waste management and disposal. The Tentative Order prescribes discharge specifications, waste acceptance criteria, and monitoring and reporting requirements for the disposal of municipal solid waste and beneficial reuse of waste and waste-derived materials at the California Street Landfill.

The Santa Ana Water Board intends to consider adopting the Tentative Order during a public hearing at a regularly scheduled Santa Ana Water Board meeting as follows:

Interested persons may attend and express their views orally on this matter at the public hearing. Oral statements should be brief to allow all interested persons time to be heard. Such comments will generally be limited to three minutes, though the Board Chair may grant additional time on a case-by-case basis.
