# AMENDMENT OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR DISCHARGES OF DREDGED OR FILL MATERIALS TO WATERS OF THE STATE RIVERSIDE COUNTY

#### **TENTATIVE ORDER R8-2024-0030**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board (Santa Ana Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment tentative Revision Order R8-2024-0030 (Tentative Order), which will amend two existing Waste Discharge Requirements Orders, specifically Order R8-2022-0009 and Order R8-2022-0029 (collectively, Affected Orders). These revisions are necessary to substitute the Dischargers (permittees) receiving regulatory coverage under the Affected Orders, and to incorporate certain new administrative provisions. Except as specified in Attachment A to the Tentative Order, no further revisions to the Affected Orders will be considered at this time.

The Tentative Order will be considered for adoption at a public meeting that will occur at the following date, time and location:

The public may participate either in person at the physical meeting location or virtually via the Zoom meeting platform. For those who do not intend to actively participate, the meeting will be livestreamed via Cal-Span.

Interested persons may attend and express their views orally on this matter at the public hearing. Oral statements should be brief to allow all interested persons time to be heard. Such comments will generally be limited to three minutes, though the Board Chair may grant additional time as deemed appropriate on a case-by-case basis.

The Santa Ana Water Board's agenda for the Board meeting will be available on the Santa Ana Water Board's <u>Agenda</u> webpage at least ten days prior to the meeting. Please check the Santa Ana Water Board's website for the most up-to-date public hearing date and location, as they are subject to change.

#### SUBMISSION OF WRITTEN COMMENTS

The Santa Ana Water Board will accept written comments on the Tentative Order during a 30-day public comment period. Persons wishing to submit written comments on the Tentative Order are requested to do so as soon as possible, but comments must be received no later than 5:00 pm on March 14, 2024.
