TENTATIVE ORDER R8-2025-0076

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board (Santa Ana Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment tentative Order R8-2025-0076 (Tentative Order) to Arantine Hills Holdings, LP (Discharger) for the Bedford Canyon Wash Long-Term Maintenance Project (Project).

The Project encompasses maintenance activities that are necessary to provide adequate flood control protection while ensuring the long-term protection of the 6.5 acres of the restored upper Bedford Canyon Wash. The construction of the Project will result in temporary impacts to waters of the State as a result of flood control structure repairs and/or removal of sediment from the Bedford Canyon Wash.

The Santa Ana Water Board intends to consider adopting the Tentative Order during a public hearing at a regularly scheduled Santa Ana Water Board meeting as follows:
