# HICKS CANYON WASH PROJECT ORANGE COUNTY TENTATIVE ORDER R8-2025-0043

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Santa Ana Regional Water Quality Control Board (Santa Ana Water Board) is releasing for public review and comment Tentative Order R8-2025-0043 (Tentative Order) for the Hicks Canyon Wash Project (Project). The Project proposal is to regrade the channel slopes through Hicks Canyon Wash to prevent further erosion, stabilize the channel banks, and protect adjacent residential properties along the southern edge of the channel. The proposed Project will result in a total of 0.97 acre of permanent impacts to waters of the State. Specifically, the permanent impacts would occur due to physical modification of 0.93 acre of Hick Canyon Wash by regrading the channel slopes to comply with the 100-year flow management practices, and 0.04 acre for the construction of the earthen berms at each storm drain connection.

The Santa Ana Water Board will consider adopting the Tentative Order during a public hearing at a regularly scheduled Santa Ana Water Board meeting as follows:
