Dear Mr. Berchtold:

In accordance with requirements of the Water Quality Control Policy for Siting, Design, Operation and Maintenance of Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems (OWTS), or OWTS Policy as promulgated by the State Water Resources Control Board on June 19, 2012, which became effective on May 13, 2013, the County of Orange (County) is submitting its Local Agency Management Program (LAMP) for approval.

The purpose of the LAMP is to allow the continued use of OWTS within the unincorporated jurisdiction of the County of Orange. Following your approval of the LAMP, the County will permit and regulate OWTS to ensure protection of water quality and public health through proper design, placement, installation, maintenance, and assessment of individual OTWS. This plan specifies minimum standards for the treatment and ultimate disposal of sewage through the use of OWTS.
