**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region (Santa Ana Water Board) will continue the public hearing to consider adoption of Tentative Order R8-2021-0011 (formerly Tentative Order R8-2020-0005), the tentative waste discharge requirements (including the tentative California Water Code section 13142.5, subdivision (b) determination) for the discharge of wastewater effluent from the proposed Huntington Beach Desalination Facility (Facility) to the Pacific Ocean.

The proposed Facility will produce an annual average of approximately 50 million gallons per day (MGD) of potable drinking water. The discharge from the proposed Facility to the Pacific Ocean will be composed primarily of reverse osmosis concentrate and filter backwash.

Interested persons were invited to submit written comments on proposed revisions to Tentative Order R8-2021-0011 that have been made since the order was last released for public review on June 30, 2020. **Written comments were due by 12:00 p.m. on March 17, 2021. The written comment period is closed, and the Santa Ana Water Board is no longer accepting written comments. The Santa Ana Water Board will not respond to late comments or to comments that are beyond the scope of the proposed revisions.**

At the public hearing, the Santa Ana Water Board will hear public comments on the proposed revisions that have been made to Tentative Order R8-2021-0011 since the order was last released for public review on June 30, 2020 and continue their deliberation on the Tentative Order. Oral comments must not exceed the scope of the new revisions and should avoid repeating previous comments to allow all interested persons time to be heard. Interested persons with similar concerns or opinions are encouraged to choose one representative to speak and are encouraged to coordinate their presentations with each
