

# SGMA

# Board Backstop Basics

- Board only steps in when local efforts fail.
- Temporarily protects the basin until locals come up-to-speed.
- Backstop is triggered by SGMA deadlines.


DWR Fails Plan & Long-Term Overdraft







# Groundwater extraction reports

Pumpers report directly to the Board annually.

- 1 Well location and capacity
- **2 Monthly extraction volumes**
- 3 Place and purpose of use

De Minimis users exempt in unmanaged areas.



Discounted rate for unmanaged extractors that use a meter to measure groundwater extractions.

### MeterCRITERIA

Permanently Installed

Equipped with totalizer

Calibrated every five years

Accurate to ± 5%
