The AHO will hold an additional hearing day for Phase 3 of this proceeding on September 26, 2023, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

BACKGROUND

On May 6, 2022, the State Water Resources Control Board ("State Water Board") Administrative Hearings Office ("AHO") issued its Notice of Public Hearing and Pre-Hearing Conference in this proceeding. The purpose of this proceeding, background, hearing issues and related information are discussed in that notice.

On September 11 through 15, 2023, the AHO held hearing days for Phase 3 of this proceeding. This order and notice follow those hearing days. Except as expressly stated

in this order and notice, all provisions of all prior AHO notices and orders in this proceeding remain in effect.

STATUS CONFERENCE ORDER

Following the hearing days conducted from September 11 through 15, the parties and the hearing officer determined that an additional hearing day is necessary to complete Phase 3 of the hearing. The AHO will conduct an additional day of hearing in Phase 3 of this proceeding on **September 26**, **2023**, **from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

The AHO intends to schedule hearing day in addition to the September 26 hearing day, if necessary, to address evidentiary or other procedural matters raised by the parties. The hearing officer intends that the parties would not be required to make their expert witnesses available during this procedural hearing day. The hearing officer directs the parties to meet and confer about scheduling an additional procedural hearing day and submit a proposed date to the AHO by **September 22, 2023, before 5:00 p.m.**

During Phase 3 of the hearing, the attorneys for Cal-Am indicated their intent to raise evidentiary objections to some of the exhibits and testimony submitted by Marina Coast Water District and the City of Marina. The hearing officer requests that Cal-Am identify the basic premise of their motion and identify the portions of the administrative record that support their motion in writing by **September 22**, **2023**, **before 5:00 p.m**. This direction is without prejudice to Cal-Am's right to raise additional evidentiary objections after the completion of the evidentiary portion of Phase 3 of the hearing. Cal-Am will have the opportunity to supplement its motion orally during the hearing and other parties will have the opportunity to respond.

Because of the need for additional hearing days, the hearing officer is extending the deadline for the parties to submit closing briefs and proposed text for the draft referee's report. The deadline for submittal to the AHO of closing briefs and proposed text for all sections and questions in the February 6, 2023 draft outline of the draft referee's report for which proposed text has not already been submitted is **October 31, 2023, by 1:00 pm.**
