Key Issues

- APCD/AQMD regulations of emission
- Food Material on SD No. 6 – divert 50% by 2020
- Mandated commercial recycling – Food in/out?
- CIWMB White Papers on food waste and AD
- RWQCB WDRs per region

Ideas

- Covered compost facilities for air emission control is good for water quality and expansion into food material feedstock
- Consistency on food material definitions, where vegetative food material could be “green material”
- Co-collected residential green waste and food waste is different from commercial food waste from restaurants and cafeterias
