To whom it may concern, we are located in the southeastern portion of California the county of Imperial. We are in a very arid climate and have less than 1.5 inches of rain per year. Our water source is Colorado river and we pay for the water we utilize. In our area of operation there are no ground water wells for irrigation, housing, or drinking purposes. We currently have containment capacity for water runoff as to prevent any water to be discharged from our composting location. We feel it is a cost burden for the proposed order to install monitors for well protection and a monitoring plan. As we do not have wells in our area , it would be timely and costly for our operation for a program that does not justify such a measure. Thank you for your time.
