


# EMERGENCY

## conservation regulation


July 2014 through November 2017

- Required monthly reporting
- Prohibited wasteful water uses
- Assigned mandatory water conservation standards




# Majority Continues Voluntary Reporting

# Statewide Urban Water Production


13.3% reduction compared to January 2013

SB 606  
AB 1668

- New efficiency-standard-based approach to urban water conservation
  - Indoor Use (set in statute)
  - Outdoor Use (adopt in 2022)
  - Water Loss (adopt in 2020)
- Updated drought planning requirements
