This public notice of draft Waste Discharge Requirements is provided in satisfaction of Water Code section 13167.5.

The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) proposes to regulate the Southern California Gas Company's Pipeline Safety Enhancement Plan (PSEP) Line 3000E Phase 2A, Kelbaker to Newberry Springs Project (Project) pursuant to the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act (Wat. Code, § 13000 et seq.). The Project will result in impacts to only waters of the state. The purpose of the Project is to conduct hydrostatic testing of approximately 60.42 miles of existing 30-inch diameter transmission line pipe along L3000E in unincorporated San Bernardino County between Kelbaker and Newberry Springs.

Staff will consider all comments submitted in writing to the State Water Board contact listed below and received during a 30-day comment period that begins (May 12, 2025) and ends at 5:00 p.m. on the last day of the comment period (June 11, 2025).
