[Participation in and coverage under DACP will be contingent upon payment of a Participation Fee which will be invoiced to Contact by the Plan Administrator on a uniform basis of \$1.40 x Covered Acres (see above). The Participation Fee for water rights within the boundaries of CDWA and SDWA are included in the CDWA and SDWA existing assessment; no invoice will be rendered, nor independent payment required for Covered Acres within those boundaries.]

Term and Termination

The DACP will be operative for reporting water use during the current Water Year (October 1, 2021 – September 30, 2022). Reporting for that year is due on or before February 1, 2023. A properly completed Application on this electronic form for that water year must be received by the Plan Administrator prior to September 30, 2022. Participation in and coverage under the DACP will become effective as described above. Unless earlier terminated as provided below, each of the listed water right(s)/claim(s) participation in and coverage under the DACP will continue from year to year so long as reporting through the DACP is allowed by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB). The current expectation is that the DACP will extend through the filing of reports for Water Year 2027 (October 1, 2026 – September 30, 2027), which will be due on or before February 1, 2028.

Each water right/claim accepted for participation in and coverage under the DACP may, by written notice to CDWA or SDWA, voluntarily terminate such participation and coverage at any time and without cause. Upon such termination, the water right owner/claimant shall be solely responsible for timely and full compliance with water diversion and use reporting required by the SWRCB, independent of the DACP.

CDWA and SDWA may terminate a water right/claim's participation in and coverage under the DACP due to any of the following:

1. Contact's failure to satisfactorily respond to the Plan Administrator's reasonable request for further information necessary to prepare a draft report for the subject water right/claim.
2. Contact's failure to satisfactorily certify report forms and the entries therein submitted by the DACP for the water right/claim.
3. Contact's failure to timely pay applicable fees.

In the event of such termination for cause, the Plan Administrator will provide prior notice to the Contact of the basis for the proposed termination, allowing the Contact 15 days to correct such failure. Termination for cause will be effective as of the day after email notice of termination is sent to Contact at the email address listed above.

Participation Fees Are Non-refundable

Participation Fee(s) paid prior to either voluntary or for cause termination will not be refunded; however, the terminated water rights(s)/claim(s) will not be invoiced for any further Participation Fees.

The Undersigned Contact Hereby certifies:

1. I am authorized to submit this Application on behalf of the owner(s) of the listed water right(s)/claim(s).
2. Each Digitized POU uploaded with this Application provides a reasonably accurate depiction of the place of use corresponding to each water right/claim included in this Application.
3. The POU for each listed water right/claim is located within the Legal Delta.
4. DACP is hereby authorized to file the annual Supplemental Statement of Diversion and Use or annual Report of Licensee with the SWRCB via the Report Management System (RMS) on behalf of the owner(s) of the underlying water right(s)/claim(s) and to obtain from the SWRCB the then-current RMS password(s) assigned to the listed water right(s)/claim(s).
5. Upon receipt of a proper invoice, I will remit the Participation Fee to the Plan Administrator
6. The Plan Administrator may rely upon the accuracy of the information in this Application.

The Undersigned Contact Hereby Acknowledges:

- 1) The listed water right(s)/claim(s) will not be covered under this DACP unless and until:
 - a) this Application is reviewed for completeness by the Plan Administrator and
 - b) The Plan Administrator has rendered, and the Applicant has paid an invoice for the Participation Fee.
- 2) The owner(s) of the water right(s)/claim(s) listed in this Application is/are solely responsible for fees, charges, assessments, and civil liabilities incurred by or charged against such water right(s)/claim(s).

- 3) After the end of Water Year 2022, the DACP agrees to prepare a draft Report of Licensee (Report) or Supplemental Statement of Water Diversion and Use (Statement), as applicable, for pre-submission review by the Contact. The amount of reported beneficial use of water will be the OpenET ensemble calculation of evapotranspiration within each POU during Water Year 2022. It is the responsibility of the Contact to review such draft(s) and either verify accuracy or propose correction to the Plan Administrator.
- 4) When satisfied with the accuracy of the Report or Statement, the Contact will certify to the Plan Administrator the accuracy of the Report or Statement to the standard required by the SWRCB.
- 5) Upon acceptance of the Report or Statement by RMS, the DACP will relay notice of acceptance to the Contact.
