Summary

The Midwestern Placer Regional Sewer Project will enable the County of Placer to decommission the Placer County's Sewer Maintenance District 1 (SMD 1) wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) and convey wastewater to the City of Lincoln's Wastewater Treatment and Reclamation Facility (WWTRF) for treatment.

The MPRSP included converting the County's SMD 1 wastewater treatment plant to a pump station that will convey sewage wastewater from the unincorporated North Auburn area of the County and pump it to the City's WWTRF. The MPRSP was divided into three construction elements: the WWTRF improvements; Reclamation and Sewer Conveyance Pipelines; and the SMD 1 Pump Station.
