### Summary

The California Department of General Services (DGS) contracted with Montgomery and Associates to provide DGS staff with a comprehensive stormwater pollution prevention training program. They conducted eight separate trainings in both northern and southern California to train DGS staff to better design, manage and inspect new DGS construction projects.

These trainings educated DGS staff on Stormwater Pollution Program (SWPPP) requirements and Best Management Practices (BMPs) to prevent pollutants from construction projects from entering waters of the state. Specific reference to, and guidance regarding, the State Water Board's Construction General Permit was also included in the trainings.

Eight separate trainings were conducted in both northern and southern California, and they were designed with specific audiences in mind. They held separate 4-hour trainings for managers and field personnel, as well as a very detailed 20-hour training to produce qualified SWPPP Developers, within the
