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NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE STATE FISCAL YEAR (SFY) 2010-11 AND SFY 2008-09 CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND (CWSRF) PROJECT PRIORITY LISTS (PPL)

This announcement serves to inform interested parties that the Executive Director of the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) intends to amend the SFY 2010-11 CWSRF PPL and the SFY 2008-09 CWSRF PPL, in accordance with the authority provided in Section IV.E.3 of the <u>Policy for Implementing the CWSRF for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities</u> (Policy).

SFY 2010-11 CWSRF PPL Amendment

The State Water Board adopted the SFY 2010-11 CWSRF PPL on June 15, 2010. Projects must be on the PPL to qualify for CWSRF financing. The proposed SFY 2010-11 CWSRF PPL amendment will add projects that may be approved for CWSRF financing prior to adoption of the SFY 2011-12 CWSRF PPL (anticipated no earlier than June 21, 2011). Projects on the PPL are funded based on readiness-to-proceed.

Per Section IV.E of the Policy, the Deputy Director of the Division of Financial Assistance (Division) is authorized to approve financing for routine and non-controversial projects on the PPL. The proposed additions to the PPL are projects with applications currently under review by the Division, which may be approved for financing prior to adoption of the SFY 2011-12 CWSRF PPL. Adding the proposed projects will allow them to qualify for financing.

SFY 2008-09 CWSRF PPL Amendment

The State Water Board adopted the SFY 2008-09 CWSRF PPL on September 16, 2008. It was subsequently amended three times by the Executive Director, to identify CWSRF projects expected to receive American Reinvestment and Recovery Act of 2009 (ARRA) funds. The following project was inadvertently deleted from the final version of the SFY 2008-09 CWSRF PPL:

The above listed project received ARRA funding, and is current nearing completion. To ensure compliance with federal and state CWSRF Program requirements, the Executive Director intends to add this project to the SFY 2008-09 CWSRF PPL.

Process for Submitting Comments

The Executive Director will consider all public comments before approving the proposed additions. The amended SFY 2010-11 CWSRF PPL will include all projects on the original SFY 2010-11 CWSRF PPL, adopted on June 15, 2010, and all projects added by the Executive Director after this public comment period. The amended SFY 2008-09 CWSRF PPL will include all projects on the original SFY 2008-09 CWSRF PPL, adopted on September 16, 2008, all projects added by the three amendments to the SFY 2008-09 CWSRF PPL, and all projects added by the Executive Director after this public comment period.

You may submit written comments regarding the proposed additions. Written comments should be submitted as early as possible to allow for thorough staff analysis. Please indicate in the subject line "Amendment to the SFY 2010-2011 and SFY 2008-09 CWSRF PPL." All comments are due by 5:00 p.m. on April 8, 2011, and should be directed to:
