# NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT

## PROPOSED ADOPTION OF THE STATE FISCAL YEAR (SFY) 2020-21 (FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR (FFY) 2020) INTENDED USE PLAN (IUP) FOR THE CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND (CWSRF), INCLUDING A SUPPLEMENTAL IUP FOR THE ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR DISASTER RELIEF ACT OF 2019 (ASADRA), AND REVISED GUIDELINES FOR THE SMALL COMMUNITY GRANT FUND (SCGF) PROGRAM (SCGF GUIDELINES)

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will accept public comment on the IUPs for the CWSRF program and revised SCGF Guidelines. The State Water Board will consider adopting the IUPs for the CWSRF program and revised SCGF Guidelines as early as the Tuesday, June 16, 2020 Board Meeting.

# BACKGROUND

The CWSRF program provides low-cost financing statewide for wastewater treatment and recycling, non-point source, estuary, storm water, and combined sewer system projects. The SCGF program supplements the CWSRF program, providing grants through Proposition 1 and other sources to small disadvantaged communities and small severely disadvantaged communities for wastewater projects.

The CWSRF IUPs outline the State Water Board's business plan for the CWSRF and the associated funding programs for state fiscal year (SFY) 2020-21, including revised SCGF Guidelines. It specifically identifies the available funding, the projects eligible for financing, the associated financing terms, and the measures that will be used to track the programs' performance.

The IUPs are required by federal statutes and regulations and will be included in the applications submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) for the FFY 2020 CWSRF Capitalization and ASADRA Grants. The SCGF Guidelines are required by Proposition 1.
