SUBJECT: REQUEST TO UPDATE THE CLEAN WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND
(CWSRF) PROJECT LIST (PL)

Per the *Policy for Implementing the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (Policy)*, last amended on May 7, 2013, the CWSRF PL is maintained to identify potentially eligible future projects and prioritize the marketing, assistance, and application review efforts of the Division of Financial Assistance (Division). A project must be included on the PL to be approved for financing, per Section XI.A of the Policy. Placement of a project on the PL does not constitute a commitment to provide financing.

The PL was last updated on June 24, 2014, and subsequently posted on the CWSRF Program web page. This update will add new projects that have started the application process since then, or remove projects that have either received a funding agreement, or that have not submitted a complete funding application within 12 consecutive months since initial placement on the PL, and were non-responsive to our efforts to update their project's status.

Section IV.1b of the Policy authorizes the Executive Director to update the PL. Upon approval of this memo, the attached list of projects will comprise the CWSRF PL, which will be posted on the CWSRF website. Division staff will use the PL, along with future PL updates, to prioritize its marketing, assistance, and application review efforts.
