As of March 12, 2014, the Monitoring and Reporting Program for the Statewide Vector Control Permit, Water Quality Order 2011-0002-DWQ¹ is hereby amended. The amendments to the Monitoring and Reporting Program replace the visual, physical, and chemical monitoring with reporting of visual observations, monitoring and reporting of application rates, and reporting of non-compliant applications. A copy of Order 2014-0038-EXEC and the amended Monitoring and Reporting Program that supersedes the previous monitoring and reporting requirements under Water Quality Order 2011-0002-DWQ¹ are enclosed.
