- The Northern Salinas Valley Mosquito Abatement District intends to make public health pesticide applications to, over and adjacent to constructed conveyances, surface waters and other waters of the U.S. owned and controlled by an entity other than the District for the vector control purposes per the requirements of the General NPDES Permit for Biological and Residual Pesticide Discharges for Vector Control Applications.
- The NPDES Permits requirements for listing of the Public Health Pesticides anticipated to be used were modified from the previous permit, to the new permit, which will be issued in 2016. The newer requirements specify that any pesticide that any pesticide can be used that contain approved active ingredients, provided all pesticide label restrictions and instructions are followed.
