2	NA	Little Butano Creek at Cloverdale Road Sediment Reduction Project	San Mateo RCD	The proposed Project will implement management measures that will improve water quality and fish passage and habitat in the Butano Creek watershed in San Mateo County. Butano Creek has been designated critical habitat for threatened and endangered populations of steelhead and coho salmon, and the Pescadero-Butano watershed (PBW) is listed under Clean Water Act Section 303(d) as impaired for fish habitat by excess fine sediment. The Project will reduce and prevent sedimentation to Butano Creek by addressing a partially plugged, double box culvert stream crossing on Cloverdale Road at Little Butano Creek that has a high risk of diversion and subsequent erosion. Little Butano Creek connects to Butano Creek approximately 1.2 miles downstream of the crossing.	\$465,000	\$160,000	\$625,000
3	NA	Scott Creek Post-Fire Recovery Sediment Prevention and Forest Management Project	Peninsula Open Space Trust	The Project will implement phase 2 of the Scott Creek Post-Fire Recovery Sediment Prevention and Forest Management Project (Project) to protect water quality and ecological function in Big Creek and Little Creek – tributaries of Scott Creek. The Project proposes to upgrade four stream crossings in very poor condition over the north fork of Little Creek, a major tributary to Scott Creek in Santa Cruz County. Replacement of the stream crossings will prevent an estimated 1,120 tons of sediment from flowing into the Scott Creek watershed due to crossing failure. Additionally, the Project aims to replace at least 14 additional stream crossings destroyed by the San Mateo-Santa Cruz Unit (CZU) Lightning Complex wildfires to reduce erosion to high quality waters of the north fork of Big Creek and Little Creek, tributaries of Scott Creek.	\$800,415	\$266,805	\$1,067,220
